Cannabidiol oil (CBD)	Over the counter	Benefits in psychosis and possibly anxiety. Sedation.
Epidiolex (CBD)	Schedule V Rx	This prescription form of CBD oil was recently FDA-approved for rare forms of childhood epilepsy.
Dronabinol (Marinol) and nabilone (Cesamet)	Schedule III Rx	FDA-approved for nausea during chemotherapy and anorexia in AIDS, these synthetic versions of THC carry similar risks as THC.
Tetrahydrocannabinol (THC)	Illegal in most states	THC is the cannabinoid responsible for marijuana's highs. It is addictive and can cause psychosis and cognitive impairment, particularly in adolescents.
