# **Common Manifestations of HPRL**

#### In women:

- Amenorrhea (the absence of menstruation for at least three cycles)
- Oligomenorrhea (infrequent menstrual cycles occurring at intervals >35 days)

### In men:

- Anemia
- · Decreased muscle mass
- Erectile dysfunction
- Gynecomastia
- Impaired spermatogenesis
- Low energy levels

## In both sexes:

- · Decreased libido
- Galactorrhea (milky nipple discharge): mainly in pre-menopausal females
- Infertility
- Low bone mineral density
